- Actively supporting Fraunhofer institutes when it comes to establishing contacts and acquiring R&D contracts with companies, industry associations and research organizations in Brazil; promoting new research and development projects in order to provide innovative and sustainable solutions from the entire Fraunhofer portfolio to potential customers
- Identifying suitable international funding announcements and research funding as well as supporting scientists and researchers at our institutes in their development of businesses with excellent partners.
- Organizing networking events and participating in research-related workshops and conferences to increase the visibility and efficiency of the Fraunhofer network in Brazil.

Qualification requirements

- Appropriate research and/or professional experience in industry/technology management (sales, acquisition, strategic alliances, research and development)

- Experience in dealing with coordination processes and requirements, especially with R&D-related companies and grant authorities

- Completed university studies in science, engineering, political science or economics; profound technical understanding (technical university degree); a doctorate will be an advantage
- Passion for international collaboration as well as for research and innovation management
- Leadership and decision-making skills, ability to delegate, and assertiveness.
- Program and project management expertise; experience in resource and HR planning as well as in process management; planning and organizational skills
- Good analytical and perceptive skills as well as communication skills, both written and spoken, in an intercultural context;
 independence, judgment and diplomatic flair, strong organizational skills, diligence and thoroughness
- Proficiency in written and spoken German and Portuguese and a good command of English
